



Stuart Dybek is the author of three books of fiction: *I Sailed with Magellan*, *The Coast of Chicago*, and *Childhood and Other Neighborhoods*. He has also published two collections of poetry: *Streets in Their Own Ink* and *Brass Knuckles*. His fiction, poetry, and nonfiction have appeared in *The New Yorker*, *Harper's*, *The Atlantic*, *Poetry*, *Tin House*, *Alaska Quarterly Review*, and many other magazines, and have been widely anthologized, including work in both *Best American Short Stories* and *Best American Poetry*. Dybek's awards include a Lannan Prize, a PEN/Malamud Award (1995), a Whiting Award (1985), a Guggenheim fellowship, and an O. Henry Award. Dybek was awarded a MacArthur Fellowship in 2007. Dybek is an *Alaska Quarterly Review* contributing editor.
