



Amy Hempel is the author of *Sing to It*, *The Dog of the Marriage*, *Tumble Home*, *At the Gates of the Animal Kingdom*, *Reasons to Live*, and the coeditor of *Unleashed*. Her stories have appeared in *Alaska Quarterly Review*, *Harper's*, *Vanity Fair*, *GQ*, *Tin House*, *The Harvard Review*, *The Quarterly*, and have been widely anthologized, including *The Best American Short Stories* and *The Best Nonrequired Reading*. Hempel is a professor of creative writing at the University of Florida. Additionally, she teaches fiction in the Low-Residency MFA Program in Writing at Bennington College.
